

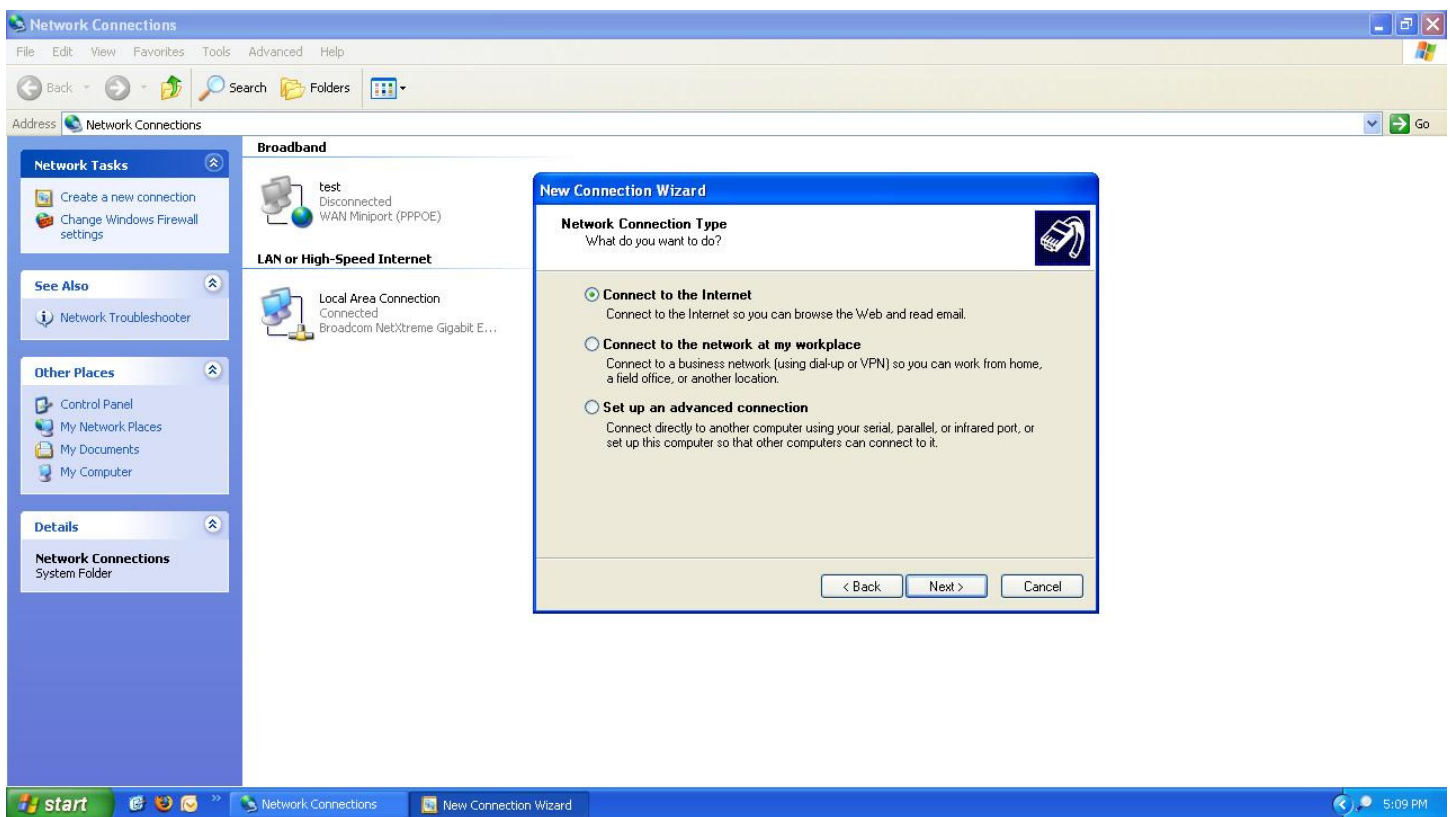
Setting up a PPPoE Connection for Windows XP



1. Go to the **Start Menu** and open the **Control Panel**. From there open **Network Connections**.

Note: If the **Network Connections** icon is not visible in the **Control Panel** click on **Switch to Classic View** on the left hand side of the window. Once in classic view open **Network Connections** and proceed to **Step 2**.

2. Click on **Create a New Connection** on the left hand side of the window under the **Network Tasks** heading. This will open the **New Connection Wizard**.
3. Choose **Connect to the Internet** and click **Next**.

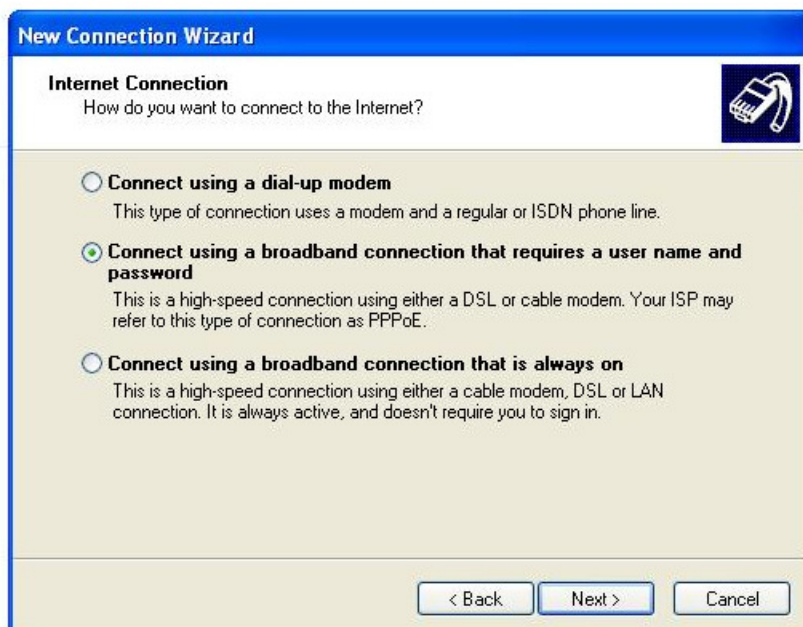

4. Choose **Set up my connection manually** and click **Next**.



5. Choose **Connect using a broadband connection that requires a username and password** and click **Next**.

6. Enter **Silo Wireless** into the **ISP Name** field and click **Next**.


